Position Purpose

The Design Engineer is a key position within Western Health, Health Support Services, providing technical input and support in relation to infrastructure & engineering services project proposals and delivery. A key member of the Engineering Services Leadership Team, this role will provide advice, input, and endorsement for infrastructure & engineering services project outputs at all stages of the project lifecycle.

The role is a pivotal conduit between Engineering Services, Health Support Services Project Team, Capital Development, and VHBA, ensuring alignment with strategic vision and contributing to Western Health's sustainable growth and Net Zero Emissions target delivery.

The Design Engineer will interface strongly with all levels of business, collaborating closely with the Clinical leads to ensure infrastructure & engineering system projects are delivered fit for the clinical and operational purposes they serve.

This full-time role will see you working Monday – Friday, across all Western Health Campuses with Sunshine Hospital as the primary office.

Due to the nature of the Department and the role, out of hours work may be required.

Business Unit Overview

The Engineering Services Directorate at Western Health is committed to ensuring that all buildings, grounds, services, plant, equipment, machinery, furniture and fittings perform efficiently, are maintained and serviced in such a manner that they provide a safe and pleasant environment for patients, staff and visitors to the hospital.

Key Responsibilities

Solution Inception:

- Partner with Strategic Engineering colleagues to review problem statements in developing investment cases and advise on solution options to achieve the infrastructure & engineering system objectives.
- Provides effective leadership and support on assigned infrastructure & engineering system projects and ensure the solutions delivered are fit for purpose and align with Western Health strategies. This includes providing background information on infrastructure and plant, providing advice on how proposed scope of works integrates with existing infrastructure and mitigate any risks of future plant failure or serviceability.
- Support the annual Capital Asset Management Plan (CAMP), and any other external or internal Infrastructure funding requests as directed by Director Engineering Services and/or Divisional Director.
- Utilise data to make informed design decisions with respect to the performance, risk, reliability, and strategic alignment of the WH infrastructure & engineering systems.

Projects:

- The Design Engineer will be the Strategic Engineering representative on all significant infrastructure and engineering system projects and will liaise closely with the Capital Development and Health Support Services Project Teams, as well as the Facilities Team for significant corrective and optimisation works.
- Sit on Tender Evaluation Panels for Engineering Services Contracts as required.
- Provide technical advice, solutions and strategies to the Operations Manager and Facility Managers, to maintain Health Services assets over their effective life cycle.
- Raise any emerging risks to WH health care and FM operations as noted during Capital development and design processes, and flag them to the Director Operations for immediate action where required.
- Report to the Director Operations and the Divisional Director, any high-risk infrastructure issues and work in conjunction with the Operations Manager Engineering on the development of required remedial action.
- Oversees and reviews reports, drawings, master-plans and strategic plans, and provides detailed comments and risk feedback to the Project Design teams.
- Ensure solution designs actively contribute to achieving Net Zero Emissions target by 2045 in alignment with Victorian Government.
- Provide specialist technical advice to internal and external stakeholders on design proposals, design changes, and test protocols for validating effectiveness of the solution design.

General:

- Provide advice, input, materials, and proposed programs of improvement and change management to the Director Operations Engineering Services, where gaps are identified that can be improved.
- Stay informed of industry best practice, emerging technologies and legislative requirements related to infrastructure & engineering system design.
- Develop and contribute to policies, guidelines, standards, and procedures relating to infrastructure & engineering system design as required.
- Partner closely with the Strategic Engineering colleagues, to capture lessons learnt, standards, knowledge, and materials that will be of lasting benefit to embed in Western Health systems and by partnering, deliver these outcomes in the best possible way.
- Ensure relationships with colleagues, patients and consumers are professional and ethical and that cultural differences are respected.
- Support and contribute to quality and continuous improvement activities.
- All emails proposals, business cases, MFD/MFI papers etc are prepared in professional manner, clearly articulating background, options, risk and recommendations and are in presented in line with agreed timeframes.
- Provide timely, expert advice.
