Applying for multiple Midwifery programs? Rank all options you are interested in on PMCV then apply separately to each of the specific Midwifery Programs and outline the multiple midwifery programs you are applying for in your cover letter.

E.g. If I want to apply for Midwifery JK, MGP JK and MGP BM- Rank Midwifery JK and Midwifery BM in PMVC, then apply to each of them on WH career site so you will put 3 applications in at WH, for this example.

Applying for both Combined and Midwifery programs? Rank all options you are interested in on PMCV then do 2 separate Applications in the 2 separate Job Adverts so you can make the application relevant to the program you are applying for.
